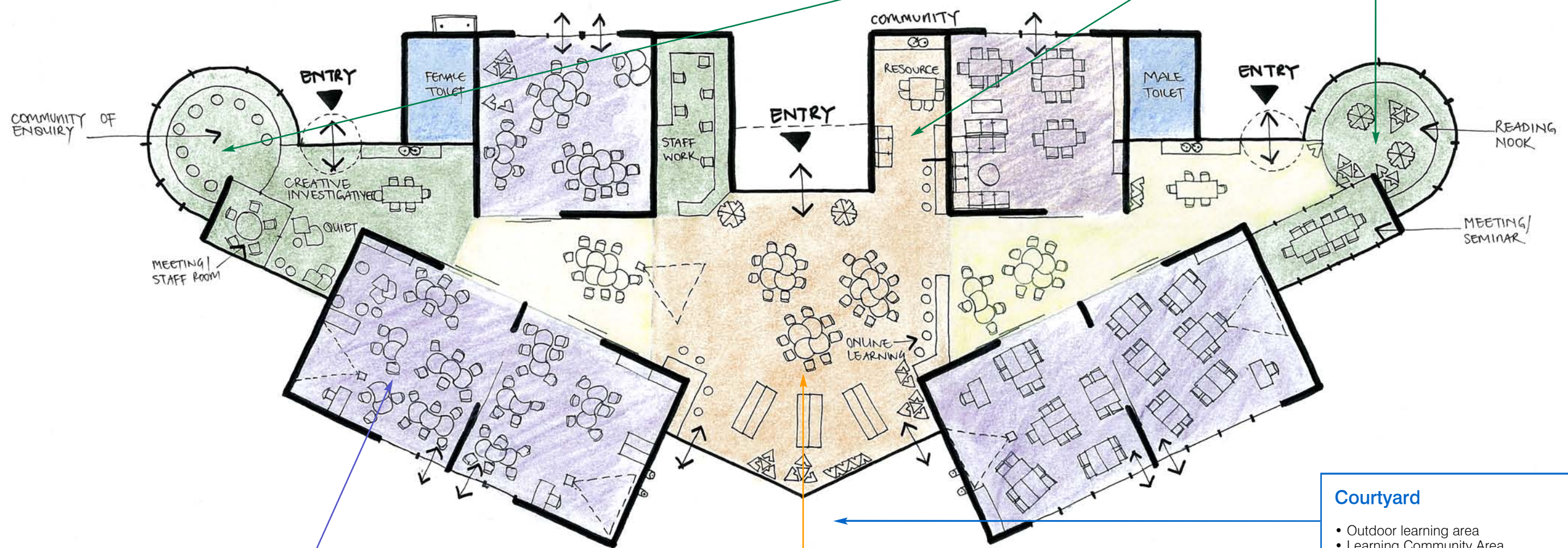


# 21C Library and Learning Neighbourhood Features

**Customisable Setting**

- Community of enquiry / quiet zone / reading zone / performance zone
- OR
- Creative / investigative space - wet area, multifunctional science, art, craft
- OR
- Community hub – kitchenette, lounge



**6 x Home Bases**

- ICT enriched
- Flexible furniture arrangements
- Zone for one to one, small group, large group
- Flow from internal to external learning court - wet area
- Age-stage appropriate specific design fit out
- Extensive glazing for natural light, visual connectedness and passive supervision
- Storage and display

**21C Library - Learning Resource Centre**

- Online research and learning
- Zones for AV editing - audio, video
- Quiet reflective, reading zones
- Resource storage and display
- Small presentation, performance space
- Small group project, games, collaborative space
- Multi-age space in contrast to neighbourhood space

**Courtyard**

- Outdoor learning area
- Learning Community Area

**Variable Features:**

1. Angle of layout around central knuckle influenced by site and existing buildings
2. External glazing variations possible - orientation dependent
3. Entry points
4. Reduction in area influenced by funds required for refurbishment of existing buildings
5. Increase in open plan space by reduction in non load bearing walls
6. Connection to other existing buildings - interconnections created by opening external wall ends
