Camp Rumbug (Grade 3/4 Camp 2017) Wednesday 19th – Friday 21st April 2017 **Equipment List (Updated Version)***

Clothing taken on camp should allow participants to be comfortable and protected in a range of conditions. Clothing should fit the person well, as ill - fitting or unsuitable clothing may increase the risk to the participants when completing various activities. The emphasis is on practicality rather than being fashionable.

- **Pillow and sleeping bag***
- Lunch/snack on day of departure (in disposable containers please)
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if you have them)
- Drink bottle
- Jumper*
- Warm jacket (it can get cold in the country)
- Two pairs of tracksuit pants or long pants
- Three pairs of shorts (one to be used for water activities)
- Four pairs of socks (please note that socks must cover ankles for many activities)
- Four pairs of underwear
- One pair of runners (for activities)
- One pair of shoes for water activities (preferably old runners)
- One pair of dry shoes for evening activities
- Four t – shirts
- Two long sleeved shirt/t-shirt (for activities where arms need to be covered)
- Sun hat
- One small packet of tissues
- Sunscreen
- One pair pyjamas/night dress
- Dressing gown (optional)
- One pair thongs (for shower use only)
- Soap /shampoo/toothpaste / toothbrush / comb / hairbrush / deodorant
- Two strong plastic bags for soiled linen
- One indoor game (no electronic games / no phones / no tablets)
- A novel to read
- One towel (for shower use) and One old towel (for wet activities)
- Small backpack
- Torch

No cameras are to be taken on camp. There will be a number of school digital cameras available and the resulting photographs will be shared with the students upon return from camp. This has been done in previous years and has proved to be a successful way of sharing camp memories.

Important Note:

It is a requirement of Panorama Coaches that all bags must be soft sided, sausage type bags (**no suitcases or hard framed backpacks**). The maximum weight is 12 kilograms. Sleeping bags are to be kept separate (not tied to the main bag). Both the bag and the sleeping bag should be clearly marked with the child's name and the school name.
