Swimming lessons for Grade 3-6 students will begin on Monday 9th October and run each afternoon for two weeks. Lessons are taught by a team of qualified swim instructors, are suitable for students of all abilities and are aligned with the Victorian Curriculum for primary school students.

Swimming lessons are not only about learning how to swim but students learn personal survival skills that improve their safety not only at the pool but also in other waterways such as rivers, lakes and the ocean. Upon completion of the program students will receive a certificate in recognition of their achievement.
